### Q. How young can I start my pets on MCT or Omega Blend Oil?

# What are **MCTs** & MCFAs..?

MCT or Medium Chain **Triglycerides** comes from Coconut Oil. All fats & oils are composed of triglycerides, but Coconut oil is composed predominately of MCTs.

# Uses and Health Benefits for DOGS

# Recommended Dosage for Dogs – 1 Teaspoon per 4.5kg

Small Dogs & Puppies – Start with ¼ teaspoon once per day, increasing gradually to recommended dosage by weight.

Adult Dogs — Depending on dogs total weight, start with ½ - 1 teaspoon, building up gradually to full dosage.

**Topical Use** - For skin & hair health, add a small amount into the palm of your hands. rubbing together, then smooth over the hair starting from the neck all the way to the tip of the tail.

Wound & Skin Care — Apply directly to the affected area 2-3 times per day.

**Oral Health** – Add a small amount directly to a dog friendly tooth brush, or add a small amount into their water bowl.

**Eye Infections** – Place oil into an eye dropper, squeeze 2-3 drops into the affected eye.

## **Recommended Dosage for Cats**

**Oral Dosage** - For an average-size cat, start by giving between  $\frac{1}{4}$  -  $\frac{1}{2}$  teaspoon once per day, 2-3 times per week either added into meals or given directly.

**Topical Use** - For skin & hair health, add a small amount into the palm of your hands, rubbing together, then smooth over the hair starting from the neck all the way to the tip of the tail.

**Wound & Skin Care** – Apply directly to the affected area 2-3 times per day

**Oral Health** — Add a small amount directly to a cat friendly tooth brush, or add a small amount into their water bowl.

**Hairballs** – An oral dosage 2-3 times per week will naturally assist with the expelling of hairballs.
